### Course Curriculum

- 20 hours of online instruction
- 5 hours of behind-the-wheel driving
- 5-1/2 hours of observation
- 1/2 hour test

### Behind-the-Wheel Driving includes:

- Highway/gravel
- Parallel/perpendicular/angle parking
- Marked and unmarked streets/intersections
- Interstate driving
- Heavy city traffic driving

## **PLEASE REVIEW THIS INFORMATION PRIOR TO REGISTRATION!**

Students turning 18 years of age **before completing** the online classroom and behind-the-wheel portions of the course are **not eligible** for this program (per DMV regulation).

### **Course Cancellation**

**Online classes are non-refundable upon registration as codes are unique to each individual.**

### **Driving Appointment Cancellation/Rescheduling**

Drive time change requests must be made through our office by calling 402.483.2511. All change requests must be made at least five (5) business days prior to the start of your first drive date. Failure to do so will result in a \$50 rescheduling fee, unless there is proof of illness with a doctor's note or death of family member with obituary.

If you must cancel your driving appointment, contact the instructor at least four hours before the appointment. A \$50 no-call, no-show charge must be paid before students can receive their P.O.P. forms.

## **Get Signed Up**

**Advance registration and payment required.**

**Students must possess a learner's permit to register and complete the course. No exceptions.**

**Registration is a 3-step process:**

**1**

**Register your student for the online portion of course.**

You will receive an email from the Nebraska Safety Council after registration and payment are received, which will provide a link and unique code for the online classroom part of the course.

If you don't receive an email, please check your spam filter.

**2**

**You will have 60 days to complete the course.**

The Nebraska Safety Council checks on class completion twice a week.

**3**

**Once completed, the Nebraska Safety Council will send you an email with a link for you to select behind-the-wheel drive times.**

If you don't receive an email, please check your spam filter.  
Drive times are first-come, first served.

**4**

**Parents must sign the policy waiver and return it on the first drive time slot.**
