Over the past four years, Southern Public Schools has adopted new curriculum in English Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies in grades K-12 to support consistent instruction in an effort to improve student academic achievement. Personal Finance Courses

Southern Public Schools requires a 5-credit hour Personal Finance Course, formerly known as Home Economics, to be taken by all students in grades 9-12 before they graduate from high school. The required 9-12 grade Personal Finance course is based on Dave Ramsey's Foundations in Personal Finance. The course is taught by Mrs. Schluter and covers the following topics listed below.

- Managing your personal finances/saving
- Budgeting
- Balancing a checkbook/debit card
- Credit Cards
- Insurance
- Investments
- Retirement
- etc.

Southern also offers an introduction to credit, savings, and investments in the Economics course taught by Mr. Doose. Southern board members, the administration, and the Southern staff believe that an understanding of personal finances is a lifelong skill that every student should have experienced during their high school education. Many opportunities are provided at Southern High School to develop an understanding of personal finance.
