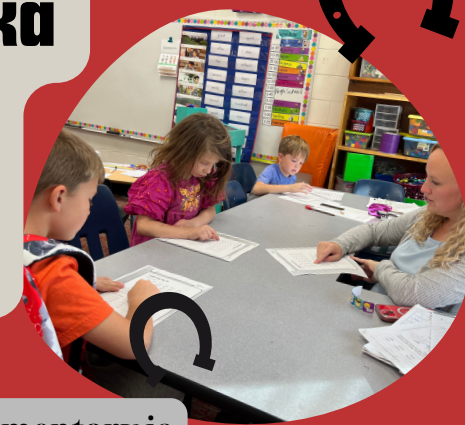




Nebraska WORDS Project

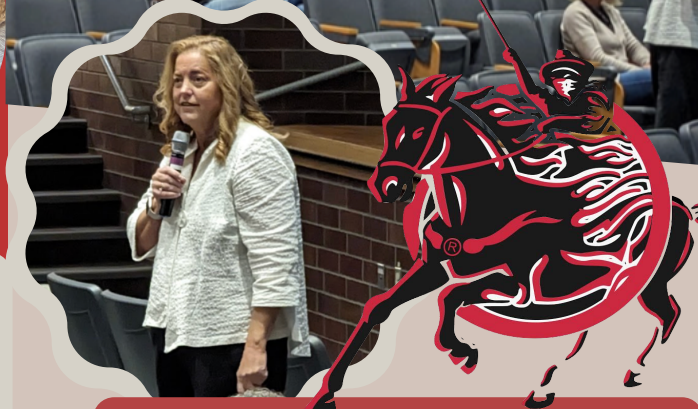
