The selection of a Scholarship recipient and an alternate may be made by your school's Scholarship Selection Committee, Guidance Counselor, and the Vocational Ag Instructor if applicable. Please email or call us to confirm the candidate selection so that we may review qualifications before announcing your final selection.

This Scholarship is intended to provide financial assistance to a student pursuing a career in agriculture and that demonstrates leadership ability to promote agriculture as a sustainable and reliable enterprise for economic growth of our area communities.

Completed applications should be returned to the school office and final selection made by April 10th, 2020. Please notify us of selection by April 10th deadline so we may send out our scholarship certificates to the school. If your foundation meets at a later date, please let us know and we will accommodate. We do request that a copy of all applications and essays be sent to our office with distinction on who the chosen recipient is.

Payment of the \$500.00 will be made after successful completion of the first semester of school and selected recipients will receive a letter notification on payment procedures.
