SOUTHERN HIGH MUSIC BOOSTERS Scholarship Criteria

The Southern High Music Boosters will offer at least two scholarships to Graduating Seniors from Southern Public High School on an annual basis. The amount of the scholarship will be at least \$250.00 with the exact amount being set by the Officers of Music Boosters Organization in the Spring of each year. You do not have to be going into music at the college level to apply for this scholarship.

The criteria for this Scholarship will be as follows:

- Any student that is intending to major or minor in music in college or that will be continuing in a college level music program will be awarded the scholarship before any other applicants are given consideration. If more than two students qualify for the above criteria the recipients will be determined by the process in item #2.
- 2. If no student is going into the music field, or if there are more than two students applying that are going into music in college, the recipient of the scholarship will be determined by a point system determined on how involved they were in the Music Program at Southern Public Schools during their years at Southern. They will be awarded one point for each year that they were involved in Senior High Band, Stage Band, Senior High Choir, and Swing Choir. The students with the most points and the most extra musical activities will be awarded the scholarships.
- 3. A student must complete four semesters of Music (Band &/or Choir) at Southern Public High School.
- 4. A student must letter in band or choir.
- 5. The applications for the Music Booster Scholarships must be turned into the Music Booster President at a date to be determined each year by the Music Booster Officers. The application will be handed out to all graduating seniors in the Music Department sometime before April 1st of each year.
- 6. The officers of the Music Boosters will review all the applications and determine the recipients on the criteria listed in items #1 & #2 above provided that they have met the requirements in #3 & #4 above.
- 7. The recipients of the Scholarships for Music Boosters will be announced at the Graduation Ceremony each year at Southern.

If you are awarded this scholarship, once you have signed up for college classes, a copy of your class registration will need to be presented to the Music Booster President to receive your check for the Scholarship awarded.
