Next, Dr. Prososki went over the post-graduate survey results, and he went over the presenters for next school year. From here, Dr. Prososki gave the school board an update on the proposed property tax reduction plan under LB 388 and LB 1331, which would totally revamp funding for public education in Nebraska. Lastly, Dr. Prososki said that he completed the Small, Rural School Achievement (SRSA) grant and the district will receive \$24,192 from this grant.
